

Admiral Hyman Rickover 1 ½" Bronze Metal with Plush presentation case.

The obverse of the medal features a bust of Admiral Rickover in civilian business dress. Above the portrait and around the upper border is the inscription "EDUCATOR·PATRIOT· ENGINEER." On each side of the portrait is an atomic energy symbol. Beneath the portrait on the lower border is the inscription "ADMIRAL HYMAN G. RICKOVER." The lower right shoulder of the portrait, along the rim of the bust, features the inscription "IACOCCA" in small letters. The reverse features a large circle within the outer edge of the medal. Inside the circle are the inscriptions, "IN APPRECIATION FOR DISTINGUISHED...CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE DEFENSE OF OUR NATION," "PEACEFUL DEVELOPMENT of NUCLEAR REACTOR TECHNOLOGY" and "SIXTY-THREE YEARS of SERVICE TO OUR COUNTRY AND WORLD-RENOWNED CONTRIBUTIONS IN DEVELOPMENT OF SAFE NUCLEAR ENERGY." The upper border within the circle features a heraldic eagle beneath a wreath with the inscription "EXTRAORDINARY" to the left of the eagle and the inscription "DEDICATION" to the right of the eagle. The lower border within the circle features an anchor intertwined with rope. Featured to the left of the anchor is the inscription "MP" and to the right the inscription "MGI." The upper rim of the medal features the inscription "BY ACT OF CONGRESS" and the lower rim of the medal features the inscription "JUNE 23 · 1982." The left and the right side of the medal rim each feature three stars. This Beautiful uncirculated Metal is still sealed in the original mint wrapping.
